STOP 1 BURNNEY'S SWEETS & MORE (30 MIN)

- Taste Burney's croissants. This is the original location for this NC favorite.
- **Time to next stop:** 0 minute walk

STOP 2 CAPE FEAR FARMERS MARKET/ ELIZABETHTOWN TOUR (1.5 HOURS)

- Begin a self-guided tour of Elizabethtown here. Learn more about this 250+ year-old town and its role in the American Revolution
- **Time to next stop:** 15 minute drive

STOP 3 JONES LAKE STATE PARK INTERPRETIVE CENTER (1 HOUR)

- Tour the interpretive center to learn about early settlers of this area, the uniqueness of the Carolina Bays and the historical social significance of this State Park.
- **Time to next stop:** 5 minute drive

STOP 4 NAVAL STORE DISPLAY AT TURNBULL CREEK EDUCATIONAL FOREST (20 MIN)

- Learn firsthand why we are the Tar Heel State and how our longleaf pines fueled the growth of our nation.
- **Time to next stop:** 15 minute drive

STOP 5 GOLDSTON'S BEACH (3 HOURS)

- Enjoy the 100 year-old lake and beach resort.
- Relive childhood memories in the arcade and mini golf course
- Explore the connection to one of America's Country Music icons at the Charlie Daniels Museum

TOTAL TIME: ~7 HOURS

Additional Notes for Goldston's Beach:

- There is a \$10 per person fee to use the beach area and amenities at Goldston's Beach.
- A splash pad was opened in 2024.
